NOTICE OF RACE

Organising Authority is the NSW & ACT District Laser Association in association with Royal Prince Alfred Yacht Club

1. <u>RULES</u>

The Championship will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, and the Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Australian Sailing.

2. <u>ELIGIBILITY</u>

All competitors shall be financial members of a District of the ILCA and of a Yacht or Sailing Club affiliated with a National Authority. Eligibility for youth age groups shall be the age on 31 December 2022. Eligibility for all other age groups shall be the age on 5^{th} March 2022.

3. ENTRIES

- 3.1 Entries can be made on-line at <u>www.laser.asn.au</u>, or at the event.
- 4. Entry is not refundable except that if the event has to be cancelled due to COVID-19 restrictions then the entry fee will be credited towards a future event.
- 4.1 Entries will be accepted up until 1130 hours Saturday 5th March 2022

5. **FEES**

Entry fee schedule:

- \$60.00 per boat or
- \$30.00 per boat youth entry (under 21)
- 6. CATEGORIES AND DIVISIONS
- 5.1 Categories are as described in the Entry Form.
- 5.2 There will be a separate start for each of Standard, Radial and 4.7 Divisions, providing there is a minimum of five entries to the Division. Division starts may be further split depending on the number of competitors.

7. <u>SCHEDULE</u>

7.1 The Championship Schedule is:

| Sun | 6 Mar | Racing | First Warning Signal 1100 hrs. Subsequent starts shall be made ASAP after the preceding race |

- 5.2 A maximum of six races are scheduled for the Championship.
- 5.3 No Warning Signal shall be made after 1530 hrs on the Sunday 6th March 2022.

8. MEASUREMENT

Each skipper shall be responsible for ensuring that their yacht and equipment comply with the ILCA rules and the Yachting Australia Special Regulations. The Organising Authority reserves the right to inspect any yacht at any time during the Regatta.

9. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available on the NSW and ACT Laser Association website <u>http://www.laser.asn.au/</u> and may be available at registration.

10. REGATTA SITE

11. RACING AREA

The racing area will be the waters of Pittwater and Broken Bay to a northern limit of Lion Island.

12. <u>COURSES</u>

The courses shall be inner and outer loop trapezoids as will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

13. SCORING

- 5.3 Six races are scheduled, of which three shall be completed to constitute a series. When four or more races are completed, the worst will be discarded.
- 5.4 Divisions will be scored as part of their fleet (Standard, Radial and 4.7).

14. <u>PRIZES</u>

Prizes will be awarded to the winners of each Division. Other prizes may also be awarded at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

15. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with a valid third party liability insurance with cover of not less than \$AUS 10,000,000.

16. DISCLAIMER

All those taking part in this Regatta do so at their own risk and responsibility.

Attention is drawn to Fundamental Rule 3 Decision to Race "A boat is solely responsible for deciding whether or not to start or to continue racing".

The NSW and ACT District Laser Association, Royal Prince Alfred Yacht Club, their officers, and the regatta officials, volunteers and sponsors do not accept any liability for the material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior, during or after the regatta.
