NOTICE OF RACE

The Organising Authority is the NSW & ACT District Laser Association in association with South Lake Macquarie Amateur Sailing Club

1. RULES

The Championship will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, and the Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Australian Sailing.

2. ELIGIBILITY

All competitors shall be financial members of a District of the ILCA and of a Yacht or Sailing Club affiliated with a National Authority. Eligibility for all age groups shall be the age on 2nd March 2019.

3. ENTRIES

3.1 Entries on the attached entry form, or on-line at www.laser.asn.au, together with the entry fee should reach the Regatta Secretary by 2nd March 2019.

3.2 Beach entries may be accepted up until 1130 hours Saturday 2nd March 2019.

4. FEES

Entry fee schedule:

- \$60.00 per boat

5. CHAMPIONSHIP SCHEDULE

- 2nd Mar 19. Registration. 0930 to 1130
Briefing. 1130
Racing 1st Warning Signal. 1330
- 3rd Mar 19. Racing 1st Warning Signal. 1100

5.1 On each racing day subsequent starts shall be made ASAP after the preceding race.

5.2 A maximum of six races are scheduled for the Championship.

5.3 No Warning Signal shall be hoisted after 1530 hrs on Sunday 3rd March 2019.

6. MEASUREMENT

Each skipper shall be responsible for ensuring that their yacht and equipment comply with the ILCA rules and the Australian Sailing Special Regulations. The Organising Authority reserves the right to inspect any yacht at any time during the Regatta.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions should be available on the NSW and ACT Laser Association website www.laser.asn.au and will be available at registration.

8. REGATTA VENUE

The Regatta venue is shown in Illustration A. South Lake Macquarie Amateur Sailing Club is located at 1A Sunshine Parade, Sunshine, NSW www.slmasc.org

9. RACING AREA

The racing area will be the waters of South Lake Macquarie in the vicinity of South Lake Macquarie Amateur Sailing Club.

10. CLASSES, DIVISIONS AND FORMAT

10.1 Classes and Divisions are as described in the Entry Form.

10.2 Men and women competitors from the same Division will race together, but there will also be separate Women's prizes (cubes) in each Division should sufficient entries be received as per ILCA guidelines.

10.3 There will be a separate start for each of Standard, Radial and 4.7 Divisions, providing there is a minimum of eight entries to the Division. Division starts may be further split depending on the number of competitors.

11. COURSES

The courses shall be inner and outer loop trapezoids as described in the Sailing Instructions.

12. SCORING

Six races are scheduled, of which three shall be completed to constitute a series. When four or more races are completed, the worst will be discarded. All Division results will be based on the ranking of competitors in the overall results.

13. PRIZES

Cubes will be awarded in accordance with the ILCA By-Laws. Other prizes may also be awarded at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

14. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with a valid third party liability insurance with cover of not less than AU\$10,000,000.

15. RISK WARNING AND DISCLAIMER

By entering competitors acknowledge the NSW and ACT District Laser Association Risk Warning.

All those taking part in this Regatta do so at their own risk and responsibility.

Attention is drawn to Fundamental Rule 4 Decision to Race "A boat is solely responsible for deciding whether or not to start or to continue racing".

The NSW and ACT District Laser Association, South Lake Macquarie Amateur Sailing Club, their officers, and the Regatta officials, volunteers and sponsors do not accept any liability for the material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior, during or after the regatta.

The Organising Authority reserves the right to refuse an entry.

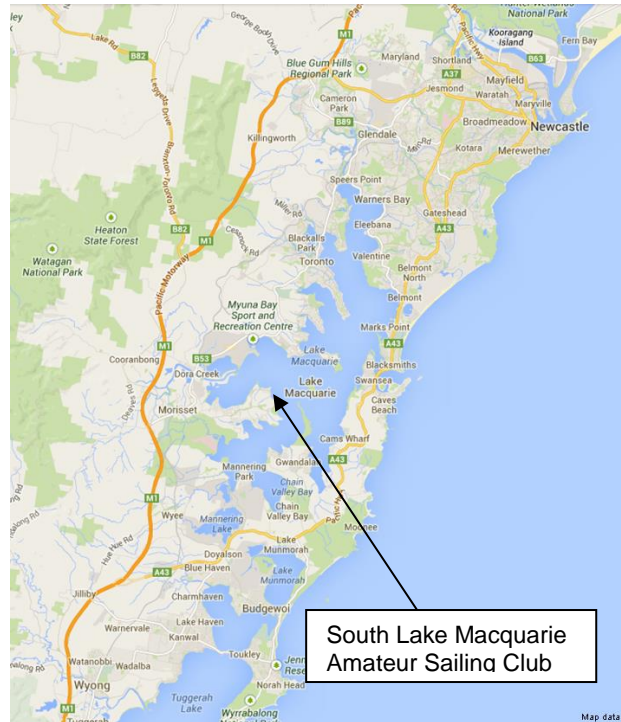
