## **NOTICE OF RACE**

**1. RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Yachting Australia Inc. (YA) – Part 1 Category 2.
- 1.3 The rules and by-laws of the International Laser Class Association (ILCA).
- 1.4 This Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

**2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all Laser Masters' sailors who shall be at least 35 years of age at 16 July 2010.
- 2.2 Each competitor shall be a financial member of a District of the ILCA and a yachting or sailing club affiliated with a state or national authority.
- 2.3 In accordance with ILCA policy, the Masters divisions shall be determined by the competitors age at 16 July 2010.
- 2.4 A minimum of five (5) entries in a division is required to constitute a Division.
- 2.5 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee to by no later than 1700 Friday 9 July 2010:

- 2.6 Online entries can be made via <http://enter.rqys.com.au>.
- 2.7 Late entries will be accepted however will incur a late fee.

**5. MEASUREMENTS**

- 5.1 It is a competitor's responsibility to ensure that his/her boat and equipment comply with class rules. Measurement and clothing checks may be carried out at any time and a boat or skipper which fails an inspection may be disqualified from ALL races held on the day prior to such inspection.
- 5.2 All competitors shall use only one hull, sail, mast and boom, centerboard and rudder during the regatta.

- 5.3 In accordance with ILCA Women's Policy, all female competitors shall display a red diamond on the top of their sail.

## 6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

## 7. VENUE

The host club is Royal Queensland Yacht Squadron, 578 Royal Esplanade Manly QLD 4179.

## 8. THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be trapezoid with Inner and Outer loops which will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

## 9. SCORING

- 9.1 The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply.  
9.2 Four (4) races are required to constitute a series.  
9.3 When only three (3) races can be completed, a boats series score will be the total of her scores for all races.  
9.4 Results for all "divisions" will be determined on overall placings.

## 10. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

## 11. PRIZES & DIVISIONS

Prizes will be awarded in all Division where sufficient entries are received (refer SI 2.4).

## 12. DISCLAIMER OF ENTRY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

## 13. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$5m per event or equivalent.
