Wangi RSL Amateur Sailing Club (WASC)**

1.0 RULES

- a The event will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, 2009-2012 (RRS), the prescriptions and Special Regulations of the YA, except as any of these are altered by this Notice of Race or by the Sailing Instructions. Yachting Australia Special Regulations Part 2 will apply.
- b Advertising will be in accordance with ISAF regulation 20.

2.0 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- a All competitors shall under 19 years of age at 31/12/2012
- b Eligible Classes are:
 - Division 1 Junior (VYC Yardstick > 150)
Incl Sabots, MJs, Pelicans & Optimists
 - Division 2 Intermediate (VYC Yardstick 116 -150)
Incl Flying Ants, Flying 11s, Laser Radials
 - Division 3 Senior (VYC Yardstick <116)
Incl 29ers, Cherubs, OKs, NS14s, MGs, Lasers
- c Entries must be lodged on the official entry form accompanied by the required fee between 9am and 10am on 11/3/2012 at WASC

3.0 FEES

The entry fee is AUD\$10 per boat for all competitors.

4.0 PROPOSED REGATTA SCHEDULE

5.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

6.0 **RACING AREA**

The racing area will be on Lake Macquarie in the vicinity of Wangi.

7.0 **COURSES**

The courses shall be designated in the Sailing Instructions.

8.0 **SCORING**

The Low Point scoring system (RRS Appendix A) will apply. Two races are scheduled for the regatta and a minimum of 1 race is required to be completed to constitute a series. Competitors will not be allowed to discard any results as all scores will count. This changes RRS Appendix A, A2

9.0 **PRIZES**

Prizes shall be awarded to:

1st, 2nd, & 3rd in each division overall

Further prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the organising authority.

10.0 **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

It is the competitor's decision to enter the Event or to start and continue in any race. Attention is drawn to Fundamental Rule 4. Competitors shall accept that their participation on the Event is at their exclusive risk in every respect.

The Organising Authority and the host sailing clubs, their officers, members, servants and agents accept no responsibility in respect of loss of life, personal injury or loss or damage to property which may be sustained by reason of their participation or intended participation in the Event or howsoever arising in connection with the Event.

11.0 **INSURANCE**

All competing boats shall have third party insurance cover of not less than AUS\$1,000,000 (recommended AUS\$5,000,000) or equivalent thereof in any other currency. A copy of such current insurance policy may be required to be provided to the organising authority.
