NOTICE OF RACE

The Organising Authority is the NSW & ACT District Laser Association in association with Great Lakes Sailing Club under the authority of Yachting NSW

1. RULES

The Championship will be governed by the 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing, the Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Yachting Australia, the rules and bylaws of the International Laser Class Association, (except as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions) and by the Sailing Instructions.

2. ELIGIBILITY

All competitors shall be financial members of a District of the ILCA and of a Yacht or Sailing Club affiliated with a National Authority. Eligibility for age groups shall be the age on 9th February 2013.

3. ENTRIES

- 3.1 Entries on the attached entry form, or on-line at www.laser.asn.au, together with the entry fee should reach the Regatta Secretary by the close of official entries on 2nd February 2013.
- 3.2 Late entries may be accepted up until 1130 hours Saturday 9th February 2013.

4. FEES

Entry fee schedule:

- \$60.00 per boat
- \$70.00 after close of official entries

5. SCHEDULE

5.1 Championship Schedule:

Sun	10 Feb	Racing	First Warning Signal 1100 hrs. Subsequent starts shall be made ASAP after the preceding race

- 5.2 A maximum of six races are scheduled for the Championship.
- 5.3 No Warning Signal shall be hoisted after 1530 hrs on the Sunday 10th February 2013.

6. MEASUREMENT

Each skipper shall be responsible for ensuring that their yacht and equipment comply with the ILCA rules and the Yachting Australia Special Regulations. The Organising Authority reserves the right to inspect any yacht at any time during the Regatta.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions should be available on the NSW and ACT Laser Association website http://www.laser.asn.au and will be available at registration.

8. REGATTA SITE

The Championship venue is shown in Illustration A. Great Lakes Sailing Club is located on The Lakes Way 12 KM south of Forster NSW 2428

9. RACING AREA

The racing area will be on Wallis Lake.

10. CATEGORIES AND DIVISIONS

- 10.1 Categories are as described in the Entry Form.
- 10.2 There will be a separate start for each of Standard, Radial and 4.7 Divisions, providing there is a minimum of eight entries to the Division. Division starts may be further split depending on the number of competitors.

11. COURSES

The courses shall be inner and outer loop trapezoids as will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

12. SCORING

Six races are scheduled, of which three shall be completed to constitute a series. When four or more races are completed, the worst will be discarded. All Divisions will be scored separately.

13. PRIZES

Cubes will be awarded in accordance with the ILCA By-Laws. Other prizes may also be awarded at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

14. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with a valid third party liability insurance with cover of not less than \$AUS 10,000,000.

15. DISCLAIMER

All those taking part in this Regatta do so at their own risk and responsibility. Attention is drawn to RRS Fundamental Rule 4 Decision to Race "A boat is solely responsible for deciding whether or not to start or to continue racing". Yachting NSW, the NSW and ACT District Laser Association, Greta Lakes Sailing Club, their officers, and the Regatta officials, volunteers and sponsors do not accept any liability for the material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior, during or after the regatta. Greta Lakes Sailing Club and/or the NSW and ACT District Laser Association reserve the right to refuse an entry.


