This is the third year for our Solidarity event & will held in Queensland during the 2025 ILCA Open & Youth Championships 1-8 January RQYS

Solidarity is about encouraging young female sailors (age between 13 & 16 yrs) to participate in a world class sailing championship. It is not about winning; the hope is that this experience will ignite a passion for the sport & that they will return to their clubs as enthusiastic ambassadors.

We know from feedback that most of the previous groups are still engaged with the ILCA's. Some have transitioned to the ILCA 6 and most have participated in subsequent State & National events.

The participants receive a free entry to the championship & social events. Charter boats & coaching are also provided. The girls will be supported by a dedicated coach who will provide on water coaching plus briefings ashore. This year we are delighted to have the support of Australian Sailing.
